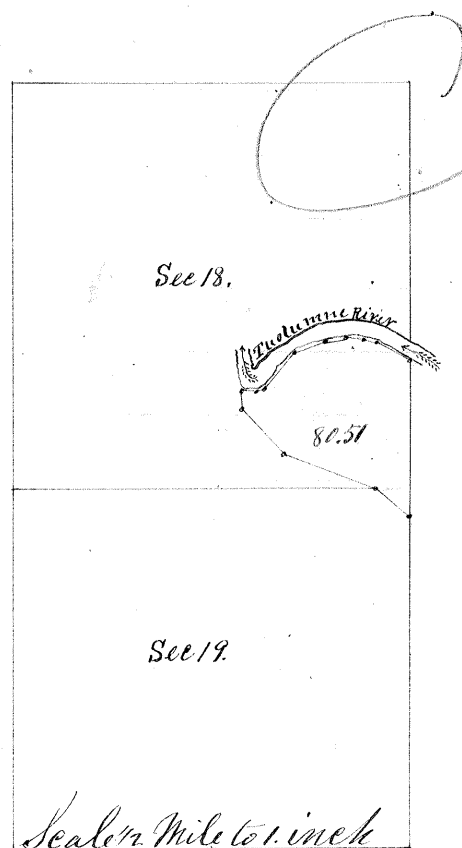

Beginning at meander post on section line between sections 19 & 20, thence run on section line $N 1/2^\circ W$ 32.60 ch to the left bank of the Tuolumne River meander down stream, run $N 63^\circ W$ 8.00 ch $N 79^\circ W$ 3.00 ch $N 81 1/2^\circ W$ 3.41 ch $S 73 1/2^\circ W$ 4.67 ch $S 69 1/4^\circ W$ 7.00 ch $S 40^\circ W$ 9.20 ch $S 60 1/2^\circ W$ 11.65 ch $N 88 3/4^\circ W$ 3.20 ch to the U.S. meander line, thence run on the U.S. meander line $S 7 1/2^\circ E$ 3.65 ch $S 21 5/8^\circ E$ 12.65 ch $S 68 1/2^\circ E$ 20.30 ch $S 51 1/2^\circ E$ 9.00 ch to the place of beginning.
