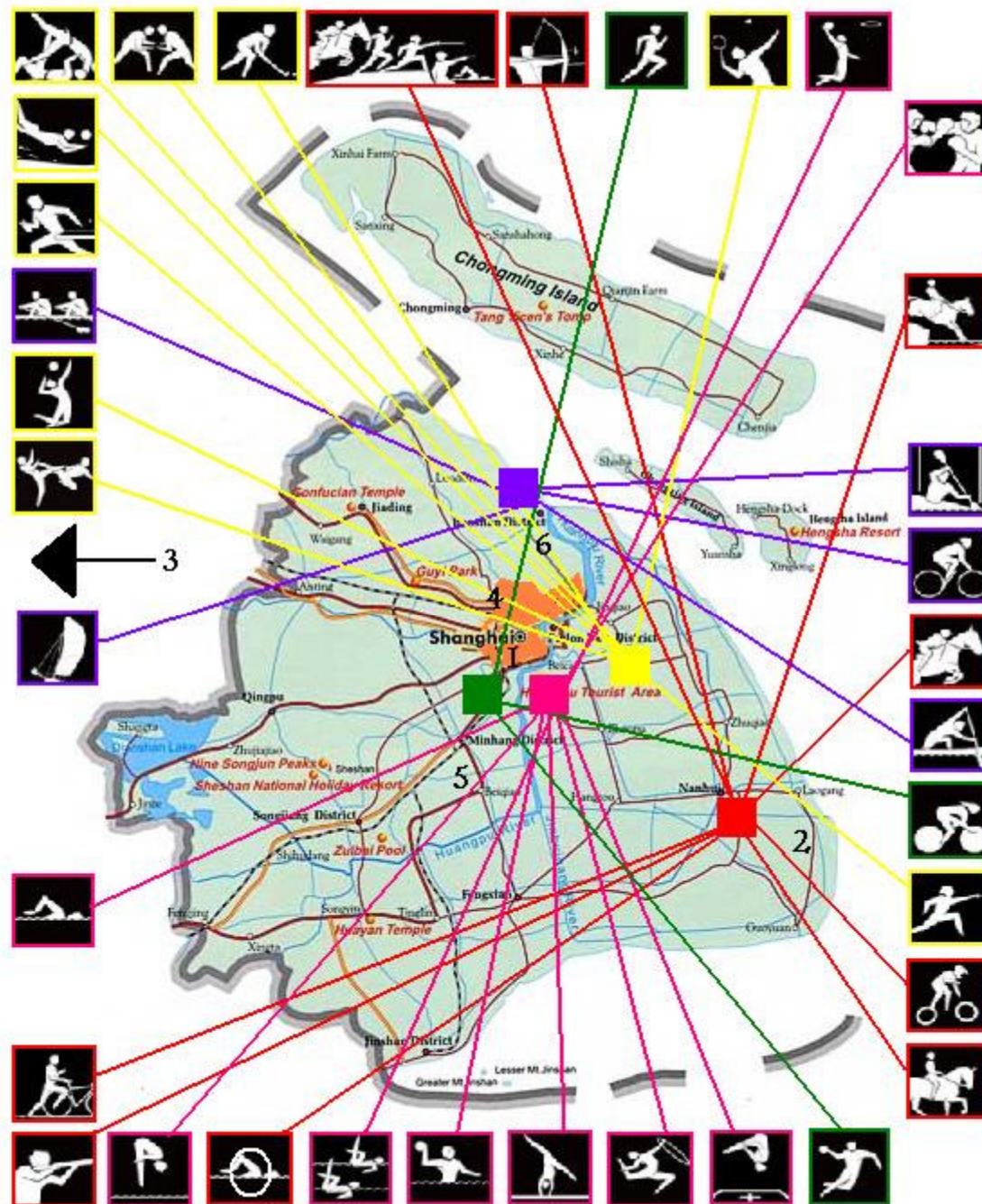

A new multisports park with temporary seating for all events - with permanent facilities to remain after the Games.

BMX - Nanhui Sports Centre (N - 6,000 + general entry)
Equestrian - Nanhui Sports Centre (N - 15,000 + general entry)
Modern Pentathlon - Nanhui Sports Centre (N - Various Venues)
Shooting - Nanhui Sports Centre (N - 8,000 + general entry)
Swimming (Open Water) - Nanhui Sports Centre (N - 5,000 + general entry)
Triathlon - Nanhui Sports Centre (N - 5,000 + general entry)

BAOSHAN CLUSTER

A combination of old and new. The home of Chinese Rowing in the future.
