 $N 29^{\frac{1}{4}}^{\circ} W 2.26$  ch,  $N 17^{\frac{3}{4}}^{\circ} W 2.18$  ch,  $N 32^{\circ} W 4.20$  ch,  $N 58^{\circ} W 3.67$  ch,  
 $N 89^{\frac{1}{2}}^{\circ} W 2.55$  ch,  $S 77^{\frac{1}{2}}^{\circ} W 7.20$  ch,  $S 72^{\circ} W 2.00$  ch,  $S 65^{\frac{3}{4}}^{\circ} W 8.00$  ch,  
 $N 83^{\circ} W 3.39$  ch,  $N 57^{\circ} W 7.27$  ch,  $N 27^{\circ} W 3.35$  ch to  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section line.  
Thence run on  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section line  $S 3^{\frac{1}{4}}^{\circ} E 4.15$  to U. S. Meander  
line. Thence run on U. S. Meander line  $S 43^{\frac{1}{4}}^{\circ} E 5.65$  ch,  
 $S 83^{\frac{1}{2}}^{\circ} E 30.00$  ch,  $S 39^{\circ} E 10.00$  ch to the place of beginning.
